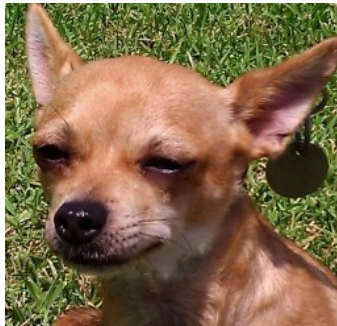

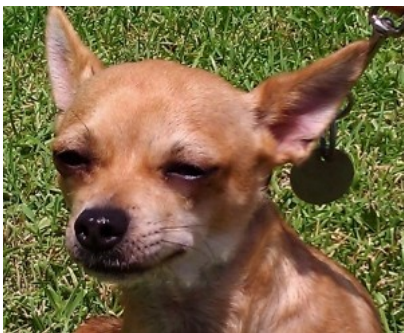
Pictured is a Kuranda bed. We use large Kurandas that have the 40 oz.. green nylon.

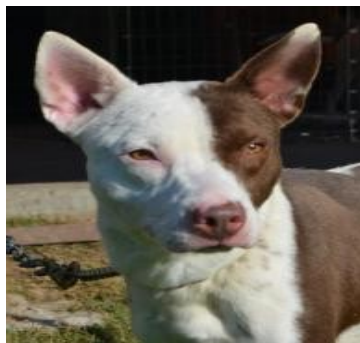
